Nobody was really sure if he was from the House of Lords

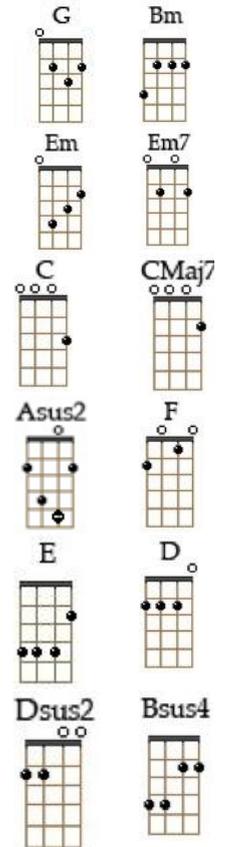
G **Bm** **Em** **Em7**
